

SYMPHONIC ORCHESTRA AUDITIONS

The Symphonic Orchestra at Center Grove High School is the advanced orchestra ensemble class. All members of this orchestra have gone through an audition process to be a part of the orchestra. Orchestra members are held to a high expectation of practice time outside of class and a high performance level on stage, as this is a weighted course. Music performed by this group is mostly from the HS Group 1 and 2 on the ISSMA list. Students are not required to take private lessons, but are highly encouraged to.

Auditions for Symphonic Orchestra will consist of two performing requirements:

1. Two, 2-Octave Scales: The fingerings on the scale sheet are only suggestions. You can use other finger patterns if that works better for you.
2. Excerpts are from repertoire to be performed in the Symphonic Orchestra in the near future.

Evaluation:

Students will be evaluated using the Center Grove Orchestras Performance Assessment Rubric.

Additional Information:

1. Auditions will take place with Ms. Deaton only. Ms. Deaton will be video recording all auditions.
2. Along with your performance, you must also have a good recommendation from your current orchestra teacher. Ms. Deaton will talk with Mr. Shimp as well as private teachers, if applicable.
3. Results from auditions will be shared one-to-two weeks after the audition deadline.
4. Ms. Deaton will make sure you are enrolled in the correct class if you are accepted into the Symphonic Orchestra.
5. Remember-there is a limited number of spots for this orchestra. Just because you don't make it, does not mean that you are a bad player.
