Why	<p>The Governor's Work Ethic Certificate Program provides students with an opportunity to identify the employability skills needed by local employers and to develop and demonstrate these skills while in high school. Students who achieve the Work Ethic standards will receive a certificate signed by the Governor and other appropriate recognition.</p> <p>For employers, the program provides a pipeline of workers with a proven work ethic and who understand the value and importance of responsibility and perseverance in the workplace. Employers may provide incentives to students who receive the Work Ethic Certificate such as a guaranteed job interview or mentoring opportunities. Business Partners will receive a window decal and their logos will be placed on our website.</p>
