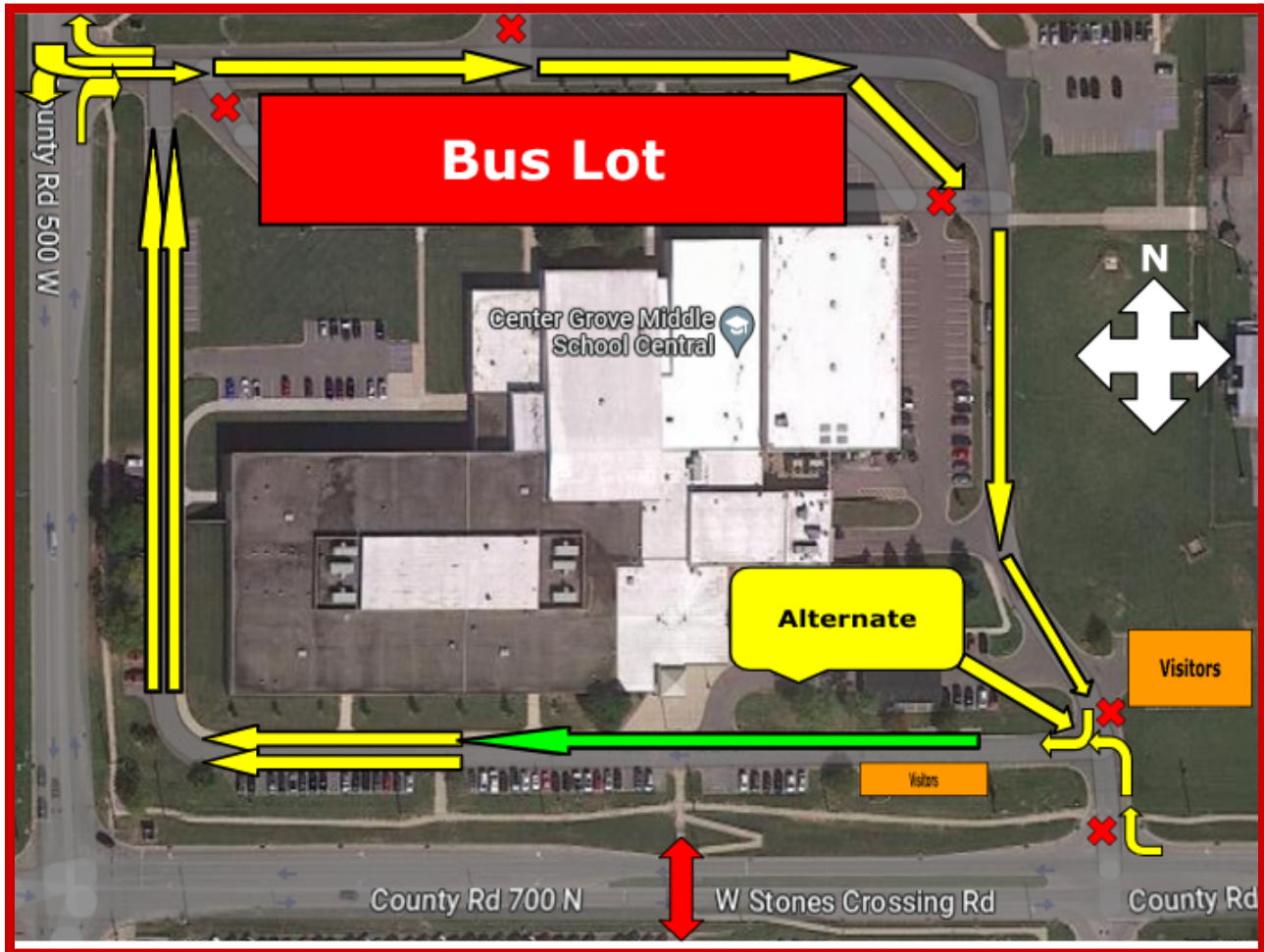

MORNING DROP-OFF & AFTERNOON PICK-UP

7:00-7:30 & 2:40-3:00 / 1:55-2:15 (W)



Drivers may enter from **Morgantown Road** or **Stones Crossing Road**. Traffic flows in a clockwise, **one-way** rotation. Please be alert and keep your speed below 15 mph.



Areas in **orange** are for visitor parking. Please park in these lots to enter the building.



The **safety zone** is identified with green paint on the curb and signage. After dropping-off or picking-up, drivers will exit the campus via **Morgantown Road**.

Step-by-Step Drop-Off/Pick-Up Procedures

- Enter the MSC campus from Morgantown Road or Stones Crossing Road.
- MSC traffic flows in a clockwise, one-way rotation.
- Vehicles will alternate from the east drive and Stones Crossing Road before entering the Safety Zone.
- Use the entire Safety Zone and leave no space between vehicles. Your student will need to walk to door #1 or to your vehicle.
- Once you pass the first sign and come to a stop, turn on your flashers while dropping-off/picking-up your student.
- Make sure your student is ready when you stop and exits the vehicle on the right side (school side). Stopping for more than a few seconds can unnecessarily delay the line.
- Please only drop-off/pick-up students in the Safety Zone along the green curb and between the signs. If you drop-off/pick-up in any other non-designated areas, you could be ticketed by CGPD.
- Please keep an eye out for students, they are not always alert.
- Once in the building, students will go straight to the cafeteria to wait for the bell. Students may NOT go to their lockers until 7:20 and must ask for permission to use the cafeteria restrooms.
- At the campus exit, the right lane turns north on Morgantown Road and the left lane turns south on Morgantown Road.
- Speed Limit is 15 mph. Signal when changing lanes or exiting the lot. Follow directions of school staff and CGPD.
- Students that walk to/from campus, including to/from CGHS, must have written guardian permission on file in the office in order to cross Stones Crossing Road.
