Dear Third Grade Parents/Guardians,

Each year, school corporations across the state of Indiana administer the *Indiana Reading Evaluation and Determination* (IREAD-3) to third grade students. IREAD-3 is based on the Indiana Academic Standards and is a summative assessment that was developed in accordance with Public Law 109. It requires the evaluation of foundational reading skills for third grade students. The Spring IREAD testing window is **March 6-10, 2023**. You can assist your child's school by making sure your child does not miss any school days that week and comes to school well-rested.

Our teachers and administrators are committed to helping your child become a successful reader. Your child's reading skill progress is continually monitored, and teachers thoroughly prepare students for the test-taking setting. As outlined by the law, students must pass the IREAD-3 test in order to be promoted to fourth grade for the 2023-2024 school year. Third grade students who do not pass IREAD-3 in March will have the opportunity to take the test again after completing our **required** district remediation program that will take place June 5 - 22, 2023.
