CENTER GROVE, IN (August 15, 2013)—The Center Grove Community School Corporation Board of School Trustees approved the appointment of Tricia Ferguson as Center Grove High School's assistant principal at its August 15 meeting.

Ferguson's appointment follows a comprehensive interview process. More than 80 candidates applied for the position; six of which were invited to participate in the first round of interviews. Three different panels consisting of administrators, staff, students and parents interviewed each candidate. A final group of three candidates were invited back for a second round of interviews with the high school administrative team.

"We are excited to have Tricia on board as the next member of the CGHS administrative team," said Doug Bird, principal of Center Grove High School. "Tricia brings a wide variety of experiences to CGHS after serving as a high school assistant principal and elementary principal with Mooresville schools. She is a long time Center Grove resident who will do an excellent job working with our staff, students, and parents."

Ferguson comes to Center Grove High School after nine years in administration in the Mooresville School System (high school assistant principal and elementary principal) and ten years as a high school social studies teacher. She brings a wide range of experience including management of curriculum and instruction, school safety expertise, and professional development for teachers. She earned her bachelor's in education from Indiana University and her master's in education from Indiana Wesleyan University.

Ferguson lives in Center Grove with her husband, Brandyn, and three children. "I am so excited for the opportunity to serve the students and families here in my community," Ferguson said. "I look forward to helping a great school continue to meet the ever changing educational demands of a competitive world."
