On Sunday, November 24, 2013, the Indiana Association of School Principals (IASP) will recognize Jack Parker, former Principal at Center Grove Middle School in Greenwood, Indiana, as the 2013 Middle School Principal from IASP District 9. District 9 is located in south central Indiana and is made up of Bartholomew, Brown, Jackson, Johnson, Lawrence, Monroe and Morgan Counties.

The recognition ceremony is a part of the 2013 Principals of the Year Recognition Celebration, a part of IASP's annual Fall Professional Conference.
