



## 2015-2016 SCHOOL IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

### **ATTENTION 11<sup>TH</sup> GRADE PARENTS:**

Get a jump start on preparing your child for his/her senior year by getting his/her immunizations up to date! The Indiana State Department of Health has added the following immunization for **all students entering 12<sup>th</sup> grade**:

- one (1) booster dose of **meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV4)**

We want to let you know now so you have plenty of time to schedule an appointment to update your child's immunizations with their medical provider.

You can now view your child's current immunization record on [Skyward Family Access](#) under Health Information.

If you are uninsured or your current insurance plan doesn't pay for immunizations, your child might be eligible to get them at the Johnson County Health Department for a small fee. Please call the Johnson County Health Department at 317.346.4368 for more information.

After your child receives this immunization, please send in or fax a copy of his/her updated immunization record to the school clinic.

**DEADLINE: Students without proof of up-to-date immunizations will NOT be allowed to attend school as of October 1, 2015 until updated records are turned in to the clinic.**
