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Center Grove approves pay increase for teachers and staff

Greenwood, IN (October 6, 2015) – The Center Grove Board of School Trustees approved during their regular meeting on Tuesday, October 6, 2015 a new Master Teacher's Contract that provides Center Grove teachers with an average pay increase of 3.88 percent and an equivalent pay increase for most non-teaching staff members.

The contract was ratified by the United Teachers Association of Center Grove (UTACG) membership on Tuesday afternoon. The new contract is retroactive to the start of the 2015-16 school year.

The agreement provides teachers with a total pay raise for the 2015-2016 school year that is an average increase of 2.61 percent. Teachers will also receive a one-time stipend that is an average of 1.27 percent. Between the base salary increase and one-time stipend, qualifying teachers will receive a total average increase of 3.88 percent for the 2015-2016 school year.

The Board also approved a pay increase of 2.61 percent and stipend of 1.27 percent for non-teaching staff members in the A, B, C, and D pay classifications. The increase is also retroactive to start of the 2015-16 school year.

"The administration, Board, and UTACG leadership are very pleased to be in a position to provide our teachers and staff with this pay increase," said Dr. Rich Arkanoff, superintendent. "We appreciate everything they do each day to provide our students with an exceptional educational experience."

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
