Four Center Grove High School musicians named to All-State Honor Band

(Greenwood, IN) - Center Grove High School junior, Laurinda Godfrey, senior, Emily Larmore, and sophomores, Mia Nunokawa and Jeremy Combs were selected to perform in the prestigious Indiana Music Education Association (IMEA) Honor Band. The band will perform during the January IMEA conference in Fort Wayne.

The Honor Concert Band is an honors ensemble that performs each year at the IMEA Professional Development Conference. It includes high school students selected from a pool of nominations sent in by IMEA member band directors. This performing ensemble works with top clinician from around the country and gives students an opportunity to play with other high caliber students from throughout the state.

Directors may nominate up to 4 students per school. Eligible students must have received a gold rating in Group I solo at the state level. Consideration is also given to whether a student has previously participated in the IMEA Honor Band or other state honor bands and whether the student studies privately.
