Daniels, Tumey Sworn In to New Terms on CGCSC School Board; Russell Named President

GREENWOOD, IN (January 11, 2017) - Greenwood Mayor Mark Myers presided over the swearing-in ceremony of Rob Daniels and Carol Tumey to the Center Grove Board of School Trustees at the Board's first meeting of 2017 on Tuesday, January 10.

Mr. Daniels was elected in November to fill the seat vacated by Rob Richards. Daniels is a graduate of Center Grove High School. He is an attorney at DeFur Voran, LLP where he serves as a partner and member of the management committee.

Mrs. Tumey was re-elected to her fourth term in November. She is an adjunct education professor at Franklin College and spent 40 years as an educator in Center Grove schools. She was also named Secretary of the Board for 2017.

Scott Alexander was named Vice President of the Board. Mr. Alexander is a 1991 graduate of Center Grove High School and lifelong Center Grove resident. He joined the Board in 2010. He is Vice President of Operations and Business Development of Reliable Solutions Corporation.
